

# MAKERSPACE POLICY

The North Manchester Public Library Makerspace is an area that allows patrons to tinker, investigate, create, and learn. Our library makerspace is housed in the basement, and is a space that can be used by all ages.

Patrons who would like to use the makerspace must:

- Obtain a key from the front desk.
- Sign their name and phone number at the front desk.

The Makerspace area is available for use Monday through Thursday 9:30 AM through 7:30 PM and Friday and Saturday 9:30 AM through 4:30 PM. The Makerspace will be closed if designated programs of the North Manchester Public Library are using the space. Patrons are encouraged to call ahead to make sure that the space is available before stopping in to use it.

The Makerspace area is monitored by camera. Should a patron fail to clean up after oneself or leave the area damaged in any way, the patron will lose Makerspace privileges, or library privileges, for a time period set by the director.
