A. Friends of the Library

- 1. The FOL Board met September 12th for their monthly meeting.
- 2. The fall book sale is planned for October 26th-28th. If you can volunteer to help with the book sale, it would be greatly appreciated.

B. Programs

- 1. This month marked Sarah's last meeting as a Firefly Early Literacy Award committee member.
- 2. Ami Brainerd of Troyer Memorial Library in Lafontaine came for a tour of the NMPL facilities. She has been following NMPL since Covid when she was a librarian at Marion Public Library. She recently became the librarian at the privately funded Troyer Memorial Library and has been visiting libraries in the area to share ideas and build connections. She told Sarah that librarians all around talk about NMPL when they meet up ("Have you seen what North Manchester is doing now!?"). She spoke repeatedly about the quality of NMPL's social media and online presence and how beautiful NMPL's photos are. She also complimented NMPL multiple times on programming and said "it is ALWAYS on point! You guys do so much!"
- 3. Diane and Sarah went to a roundtable as part of the efforts of Manchester University and the Community Foundation of Wabash County to win a \$25 million grant from the Lilly Endowment for its College and Community Collaboration Initiative. Sarah was able to connect with Mackenzie Coulter-Kern who is finishing up a needs assessment of North Manchester's Spanish speaking community. NMPL hopes to reach out to her in the future for potential inroads to recruit Spanish speaking staff for the library as part of the long range plan.
- 4. The One State/One Story resource guide for Freedom Over Me that Suzanne Walker of the Indiana State Library and Sarah worked on this year has officially been released One State / One Story - Indiana Humanities. Indiana Humanities is providing \$750 grants, books and promotional materials for host organizations to design and implement programs in 2024. The deadline for applying is November 10, 2023. Sarah plans to apply for this grant.

- 5. The Summer Splash party ended on a sweet note! 68 patrons went to the Strauss Peabody Aquatic Center and had a great time enjoying the pool, slides and the splash pad outside.
- 6. Molly held a program towards the end of August teaching patrons how to make aromatherapy stress balls. Molly had a great response from patrons young and old.
- 7. Babytime made its first debut on 9/7! NMPL had 22 total in attendance (counting the parents/guardians) and they all played with sensory toys and read a board book about belly buttons. Babytime will be on Thursday mornings at 10 AM.
- 8. Paint by Sticker has made a comeback to the program lineup. For the month of September, every Tuesday patrons can go to the conference room at 3:45 to relax, listen to music and create a masterpiece.
